

Kerbs and cracks

Plant id sheet



These species are commonly found growing at the side of kerbs, in paving and cracks in pavements. Keep an eye out in other places too, though, because they grow in other places as well.



Matricaria discoidea (pineapple weed)

- Yellow, domed flowerheads
- Feathery leaves
- Smells like pineapple when rubbed
- Family: [Asteraceae](#)



Sagina procumbens (procumbent pearlwort)

- Forms tufts
- Stems radiate from central rosette
- No petals or small white petals
- Family: Caryophyllaceae



Poa annua (annual meadow grass)

- Short, tufted grass
- Short, pale flower spikes
- Family: Poaceae



Senecio vulgaris (groundsel)

- Yellow flowerheads
- Lobed, glossy leaves
- Fluffy seedheads
- Family: [Asteraceae](#)
