

Edges and hedges

Plant id sheet



These species are commonly found growing at the side of paths and buildings and at the foot of hedges. Keep an eye out in other places too, though, because they grow in other places as well.



Stellaria media (chickweed)

- Small, white flowers
- Opposite leaves
- Leaves oval with pointed tips
- Family: [Caryophyllaceae](#)



Alliaria petiolata (garlic mustard)

- White, 4-petaled flowers
- Leaves triangular and toothed
- Garlic smell when rubbed
- Family: [Brassicaceae](#)



Lamium album (white dead-nettle)

- Leaves downy
- Toothed leaf edges
- Whorls of white flowers
- Family: [Lamiaceae](#)



Urtica dioica (stinging nettle)

- Leaves have stinging hairs!
- Strongly toothed leaf edges
- Clusters of tiny green flowers
- Family: [Urticaceae](#)
